CURRICULUM STATEMENT


At Holly Lodge, everyone works to ensure that all children are happy, healthy and safe.

Assessment

At Holly Lodge, both adults and children have very high expectations and aspirations for learning. We encourage children to continually reflect on their progress through learning conversations and regular, targeted feedback. As a result, they are able to identify their own next steps in order to set and choose their own challenges.



Learning at Holly Lodge is based around our exciting cross-curricular themes that immerse children in engaging and meaningful experiences, often reflecting their interests. We provide opportunities where children are encouraged to take ownership of their learning through the process of 'plan, do, review'. Our themes are designed so that children are involved in a wide range of collaborative and independent learning experiences.
