Dear Parents and Carers

welcome back! We wish all our families a healthy and happy new year. I hope you all had an enjoyable Christmas. It was lovely to see the eagerness and enthusiasm of the children, as they returned to school this week.

Our REACH school value is Achievement this half term. This week our focus word for achievement is "Journey" — teaching the children that achievement is like a journey — there will be ups and downs. Making mistakes or going through tough times are part of that journey. The important thing is to keep going and learn from mistakes. The small changes and the regular practice are all steps to achieving. This is where you can help your child to cultivate those good habits. E.g. just 5 minutes of regular reading every day and 5 minutes on times table practice may not seem much but accumulates throughout the year and always leads to progress.

We are still supporting children to fill in gaps in learning as a result of Covid closures and are making use of the additional Government funding to support with small groups to give targeted extra support. Thankfully Covid numbers are very low as we return to school. We review our risk assessments regularly. The latest risk assessment and contingency plan can be found on our website. We aim for children to have a full and "normal" experience at school and only put in additional measures if we have a Covid outbreak in conjunction with the UK Health Security Agency advice. Parents will be informed if there is an outbreak in a class (not individual cases). The Government undertake any track and trace to make contact where appropriate.

For Years 1-6, please do make sure you have signed up to the report portal for autumn reports which will be available from 17^{th} January.

We have now confirmed our final INSET date for this academic year: Friday 27th May 2022. Please see below for dates which will be added to as they are available.
