Holly Lodge Easter Charity Run



Each year our pupils take part in an Easter run to raise money for charity. This year we have chosen to donate to the **DEC Ukraine Humanitarian Appeal**:

"Intense conflict in Ukraine is threatening the lives and livelihoods of civilians across the country, causing hundreds of thousands to flee. Homes have been destroyed or are unsafe to live in. Essential services have been hit. Families have been separated. People have been injured. Lives have been lost. DEC charities and their local partners are in Ukraine and across the border in the neighbouring countries. They are working to meet the immediate needs of all people fleeing with food, water, medical assistance, protection and trauma care.

- £30 could provide essential hygiene supplies for three people for one month
- £50 could provide blankets for 4 families to keep them warm
- £100 could provide emergency food for two families for one month

The DEC brings together 15 leading aid charities to raise funds quickly and efficiently at times of crisis overseas. In these times of crisis, people in life-and-death situations need our help and our mission is to save, protect and rebuild lives through effective humanitarian response.

Pooling our resources to work as one, we are pivotal in co-ordinating the UK public's response to overseas disasters. In collaboration with our Rapid Response Network of national media and corporate partners, we raise the alarm to the UK public and set up easy ways for them to donate. And we have immediate impact, getting aid to people who need it, fast.

The run will take place on **Wednesday 30th March** during the school day. (Unfortunately, we aren't able to invite parents on this occasion) **Pupils may wear sportswear for the day - including blue and yellow** (although this isn't essential) - to represent the Ukrainian flag.
